

WRETHAM PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of a Meeting of Wretham Parish Council held on Thursday, 11 April 2019 at 7.00 p.m. in Wretham Village Hall, Church Road.

1 **Apologies for absence.** None.

2 **Declarations of interest.** None

3 **Dispensations.** None.

4 **Public participation session.**

4.1 A member of the public asked about the situation regarding the bottle bank. The Clerk advised that Viridor had now removed their old bank, and members of the Village Hall Trustees present confirmed that they were happy for the new ban to remain in the position it was rather than being moved to where the Viridor one was. He had sent off a claim for recycling credits on the last glass taken away by Viridor. He was aware that Viridor had been trying to incorrectly add charges for the last two collections to the Village Hall's account, and had contacted them twice pointing out that, (a) the glass collection was nothing to do with the Hall, and (b) the Council had not agreed to the imposition of a collection charge and most certainly not signed any sort of contract to pay this, and therefore the old agreement that collections would be free of charge still applied. He suggested that the Village Hall tell Viridor not to attempt to pass charges relating to their other customers to the Hall account.

4.2 The Clerk advised the Council that he had been appointed Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer to Snetterton Parish Council, bringing his stable of Councils to a total of five.

9 Finance.

9.1 **Training.** It was **resolved** that cheque number 100733 for £13.75 to the Norfolk Association of Local Councils be signed, in part payment of their invoice no. 2481, being this Council's share of the cost of the Clerk attending the Spring Conference on 14 March 2019. (*Local Government Act 1972 s. 111*)

9.2 **Hire of venue.** It was **resolved** that cheque number 100734 for £56.25 to Wretham Village Hall be signed, in settlement of invoice no. 74 for hire of the Hall for meetings during the year 2018/19. (*Local Government Act 1972 s. 132*)

9.3 **Subscriptions.** It was **resolved** that cheque number 100735 for £36.00 to the Campaign to Protect Rural England be signed, being the subscription for the year ended 10 May 2020. (*Local Government Act 1972 s.111(1)*)

9.4 **Subscriptions.** It was **noted** that on or around 18 April 2019 the Information Commissioner's Office will collect £35.00 from the Council's account by direct debit, being the new data protection fee due under the *Data Protection (Charges and Information) Regulations 2018*. Under the new Regulations organisations which are required to register must pay an annual fee, depending upon size or turnover, of £40.00, £60.00 or £2,900.00. Public authorities all fall within Tier 1, so must pay £40.00, but receive a £5.00 reduction if they pay by direct debit; hence only £35.00 is due. This fee replaces the annual registration fee of £35.00 which was required under the *Data Protection Act 1998*.
