- Apologies for absence. None. 1
- Declarations of interest. None 2
- 3 **Dispensations**. None.
- Public participation session. District Councillor Phil Cowen gave an update of how his 4 council was continuing to work throughout the Government's measures to combat coronavirus.
- Minutes. The minutes of the meeting held on Thursday, 12 March 2020 were confirmed for 5 retrospective signing by the Chairman of the next face-to-face meeting of the Council.
- Matters arising. 6
 - [4.1] Litter Pick. As a result of the coronavirus pandemic, this has been cancelled. 6.1
 - [4.2] Tree felling in church road. The arboriculturalist has confirmed that the land 6.2 owner is responsible for and will be clearing the debris in due course.
 - [4.3] Future meetings. The Coronavirus Act 2020 gave the Minister of State power to 6.3 pass secondary legislation to enable virtual meetings, and this has been done in The Local Authorities and Police and Crime Panels (Coronavirus) (Flexibility of Local Authority and Police and Crime Panel Meetings) (England and Wales) Regulations 2020. These Regulations have also temporally removed the necessity of posting notice of meetings in a conspicuous place in the parish (although agendas must still be published on the website), and holding the Annual Meeting of the Parish Council this year. The Clerk added that The Accounts and Audit (Coronavirus) (Amendment) Regulations 2020 were published on 7 April and come into effect on 30 April. These basically put the schedule back by two months.
 - [6.5] Deer Sign. Hockham Parish Council has now advised that it changed its mind 6.4 about joining with Stow Bedon & Breckles PC and this Council in the project to install this sign along the A1075 Unfortunately they but did not think to advise the other Councils involved, nor apparently, County Cllr. Fabian Eagle about this. However, as this will means that less posts and brackets will need to be purchased, and thanks to the grants from both the Parish Partnership Scheme and Cllr. Eagle's budget, this will only result in a small increase in the initial cost to the two remaining parishes, and a bit more on the annual running costs.

8 Planning.

- 8.1 3PL/2020/0305/VAR: Stonebridge Camp, Thetford Road. Variation of Condition 1 & 7 on 3PL/2016/0939/VAR Replace drawing 'Proposed Site Plan 2364-002 Rev M' with drawing 'Proposed Site Plan 2364-002 Rev O'. It was resolved that the Council objected strongly to the attempt to get out of the previously agreed planning obligation to provide children's play equipment on the site. The applicant has suggested that this is not needed now that the Village Hall Trustees have installed some equipment, but this for adult exercise, and not children's play.
- 8.2 3PL/2020/0329/HOU: Wretham Manor, Church Road. Replacement of 6 no. 1st floor windows. It was resolved that the Council had no objections.
- 8.3 **3PL/2020/0330/LB: Wretham Manor, Church Road**. Replacement of 6 no. 1st floor windows. (Application for Listed Building consent.) It was **resolved** that the Council had no objections.
- 8.4 **3PL/2020/0190/F: 4 Manor Cottages, Church Road, Wretham**. Erection of 3 bed single storey detached dwelling with attached double garage & detached tractor port. Refusal of Planning Permission dated 8 April 2020 was **received**.
- **Defibrillator**. The response of the National Lottery Awards for All, regarding the application for a grant for a defibrillator, saying it is unable to fund the project, was **received** with regret. It was **agreed** that the Council should follow the advice of the Heartbeat Trust and re-apply, but first try to obtain more evidence that the project had the strong support of the residents.
